

Class Guidelines

- Please arrive early before you class begins to warm up and properly prepare your muscles for class.
- Anyone arriving after pliés will be asked to observe and take notes. This is for the safety of your dancer to avoid injury.
- Go to the restroom before class.
- Please bring a water bottle to class.

Make-ups

- If your child is sick, please do not bring them to class. However, if your child has an injury and is unable to dance, please bring them to class to observe.
- Make up classes are welcomed and encouraged. Please make up your class in the same level, or one level below your current level.

Communication

- We would appreciate a note notifying your instructor of an upcoming absence. For same day absences an email is appreciated.
- If you would like to speak with a teacher, please leave us a note at the front desk with your name, number, the best time to reach you, and we will call you. Or please email to set up a time to talk. Please do not enter the classroom unless it is an emergency.

Dress Attire

 - Black leotard, pink or skin-tone tights with matching soft ballet shoes.
 - Fitted white or black tee, black footed tights, black ballet shoes.
- Hair is pulled back in a neat and tidy bun which is secured with a hair net and bobby pins.
- Small earrings are allowed, no necklaces, rings and bracelets please.
